MY PARTNER'S NAME IS DAVE AND I REFER TO HIM AS "THE RANCHER" AS HE SEES TO ALL OF THE RANCH OPERATIONS. AS A FAMILY WE LOVE TO COOK NEW DISHES, CAMP, FISH, PADDLE BOARD, SWIM IN THE ANIMAS, PLAY FUN GAMES, ROAD TRIP TO THE OCEAN, HARVEST VEGETABLES, AND WORK TOGETHER ON THE RANCH.
